DEE DEE: I'd splurge on shoes before a dress or

ELISHA: I'd make my date carry my lip gloss for a great pair of shoes. And Dee Dee would just take my lip gloss because she would want mine anyway.

FOTC: Any other advice for the upcoming holiday season?

DEE DEE: It's a good time in our lives right now, in a sense that everything, including the economy, is getting better. Be happy where you are right now in your life.
